• Out of Network This plan does not cover services with out-of-network providers, except for Emergency and Urgent Care. All services must be coordinated with the Primary Care Clinic (PCC).

Important Questions	Answers	Why this Matters:
What is the overall deductible?	\$750 individual / \$1,500 family medical in-network	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay.  This <u>plan</u> has an embedded <u>deductible</u> . If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Well child care, prenatal care and in-network preventive care services are covered before you meet your deductible.	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost-sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No	You don't have to meet <u>deductibles</u> for specific services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?	\$2,400 individual medical <u>in-network</u> \$4,800 family medical <u>in-network</u> \$1,050 individual drug <u>in-network</u> \$2,100 family drug <u>in-network</u>	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services.  This <u>plan</u> has an embedded <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> . If you have other family members on this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limits</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.
What is not included in the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> ?	Premiums, balance-billing charges (unless balanced billing is prohibited), and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>out-of-pocket</u> <u>limit</u> .

Do you need a referral to see a specialist?	Yes	This <u>plan</u> will pay some or all of the costs to see a <u>specialist</u> for covered services but only if you have a <u>referral</u> before you see the <u>specialist</u> .
Will you pay less if you use an in-network provider?	Yes. This <u>plan</u> uses a <u>provider network</u> . You will pay less if you use a <u>provider in the plan's network</u> . You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> , and you might receive a bill from a <u>provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your <u>plan pays (balance billing)</u>. Be aware your <u>in-network provider might use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <u>provider before you get services</u>.</u></u>
